Bojan Blagojevic received his veterinary degree in 2006, MSc degree in food hygiene in 2008 and became PhD in veterinary medicine at the University of Novi Sad in 2011. He is European Specialist in Veterinary Public Health - subspecialty Food Science from 2013 (ECVPH Diplomate). Dr Blagojevic is appointed as Associate Professor in Meat Hygiene and Safety at the Department of Veterinary Medicine, University of Novi Sad and in Food Safety Risk Assessment at Faculty of Agriculture, University of Belgrade. He is Secretary Elect of the European College of Veterinary Public Health and Serbian representative in the European Board of Veterinary Specialisation. His main research interests include risk assessment of public health and animal health and welfare hazards, risk based meat inspection, abattoir process hygiene and meat decontamination. He has been involved in EU FP6 project "ProSafeBeef" and in two projects funded by the Food Standards Agency addressing meat inspection revision in the United Kingdom. He is currently coordinator of the Serbian Ministry of Education, Science and Technological Development project TR31034 and chair of the EU COST Action CA18105 "RIBMINS".
