Short biography: She recently developed a key project in broilers myopathies. Main research topics are rabbit science, poultry science, aquaculture; effect of rearing system on welfare and meat quality in rabbits and poultry; factors affecting product quality. Author and co-author of more than 200 original scientific documents (104 Scopus publications; H-index 25; 1932 citations; March, 2023). Scientific responsible of several national competitive projects and research contracts/consultancies with public Institutions and non-academic partners in poultry and rabbit science. Supervisor of Fellowship Marie-Curie project PISCOPIA (2014-18) and DEMyo (Development of myopathies in broiler chickens with a special insight into spaghetti meat; 2022-2024).
