Short biography: Dr Jelena Maletić, graduated in 2006, and defend her doctoral dissertation, ("Evaluation of genotoxic effects and pathomorphological changes in rats after tulathromycin application"). She defended her specialistic thesis in September 2020 (thesis title "Infectious laryngotracheitis - the emergence of the virus in the Republic of Serbia") and in September 2022 graduated in Specialist Studies - Microbiology with Immunology at the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine in Belgrade.

At the Scientific Institute of Veterinary Medicine of Serbia, dr Jelena Maletić studies poultry and wild bird diseases of bacterial, viral, fungal, and parasitic etiology (pathomorphological characterization, serological diagnosis, and molecular characterization). As part of his scientific work, one part of the study refers to the area of application of biosecurity measures and welfare during the production of the poultry of different categories (broiler and parent flocks).
