*Short biography:* Ksenija Nešić, DVM,MSc,PhD (Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, University of Belgrade) in her research connects the links of the food chain within the "one health" concept. The main topic is nutritional toxicology, predominantly mycotoxicology, as well as the study of other undesirable and harmful ingredients in terms of their detection and diagnostic measures in order to prevent foodborne diseases. Scientific work is also focused on the improvement of laboratory methods for feed control and participation in the studies of the influence of animal nutrition on the quality of food of animal origin. International activities and cooperation with leading European institutions are particularly significant, while membership in domestic and international associations, as well as in editorial boards of international and leading national scientific journals, is noteworthy. She contributes to the development of feed legislation in the Republic of Serbia with the aim of end consumers protection equivalent to the EU level.
