Short biography: Dr Milica Glišić is a research associate at the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, University of Belgrade, Serbia. From 2014-2019, she participated in the project of the Ministry of Education, Science and Technological Development of the Republic of Serbia No. TR 31034, while from 2022 manages the Working Package of the project: Value-Added Products from Maize, Wheat and Sunflower Waste as Raw Materials for Pharmaceutical and Food Industry (PhAgroWaste), financed by the Science Fund of the Republic of Serbia. She published more than 80 scientific and conference papers of which 16 were in SCI journals, and two book chapters. Her main field of expertise is improving meat quality through nutrition modification and reformulation of meat products in terms of applying plant extracts rich in bioactive compounds as natural preservatives and producing meat products with reduced fat content and improved nutritional composition using fat substitutes in the forms of organo- and oleogels.
