Short biography: Svetlana Grdović was born in 1968 in Belgrade, where she completed primary and secondary school. She graduated from the Faculty of Biology at the University of Belgrade in 1992, received her master's degree in 1997, and her doctorate in 2003. He is the winner of the Annual Award of the Belgrade Chamber of Commerce for one of the 4 best doctoral dissertations in Serbia in 2003. The title of the dissertation is "Bryoflora of the wider area of Belgrade - diversity, ecology and bioindicator importance". She spent a short specialization at the Botanical Museum and Botanical Garden in Berlin. She is the author and co-author of more than 90 scientific papers and publications in the field of Botany and Nutrition. He is the co-author of the textbook "Forage Plants", the author of the textbooks "Botany" and "Practice in Botany", as well as the monograph "Mosses of the wider area of Belgrade and their bioindicator importance". She is employed as a full professor at the Department of Nutrition and Botany, Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, University of Belgrade, where she teaches the subjects Botany and Medicinal and Poisonous Plants of the Balkans.
