Short biography: Dr. Tijana Ledina is Assistant Professor at the Department of Food Hygiene and Technology. She teaches the following courses: Milk Hygiene and Technology, Basic Principles of Food Hygiene, Control of Food of Animal Origin and Introduction to Veterinary Laboratory Practice. Dr. Ledina participates in two projects funded by the Ministry of Science, Technological Development and Innovation of the Republic of Serbia. Her research activity is focused mainly on milk and dairy products microbiology, i.e. Lactic Acid Bacteria, and ecology of antimicrobial resistance in the food chain. She was employed as a Junior Expert in creating Strategy for the achievement of raw milk EU quality standards, funded by the EU and the Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry, and Water Management of the Republic of Serbia.
