Short biography: Burcu Kerimoğlu works as an Associate Professor at the Department of Food Engineering, Ege University, İzmir, Türkiye, with over 20 years of academic and applied research experience in food science and technology. She received her PhD in Food Technology in 2018 and her associate professorship in 2022. Her research focuses on meat science and technology, particularly sustainable and functional meat products, waste valorization through green bioconversion approaches, and animal-sourced bioactive peptides. In 2021, she conducted a postdoctoral study at the Institute of Agrochemistry and Food Technology (IATA-CSIC) in Valencia, Spain, on the recovery of bioactive peptides from poultry by-products. She has contributed to several research projects and authored various peer-reviewed publications in her field. In addition to her research, she is actively involved in teaching and supervision activities, and she serves as the Accreditation Coordinator as well as the Institutional Vice Erasmus Coordinator.
