He leads and participates in several regional and international projects focused on strengthening veterinary services, surveillance, zoonotic disease control, and food safety systems. Author of numerous scientific publications, he is widely recognized for advancing veterinary education, policy, and workforce development in Europe and the Mediterranean region.
