Short biography: Prof. Dr. Svetlana Grdović was born in Belgrade, where she completed primary and secondary school. She entered the Faculty of Biology at the University of Belgrade and graduated in 1992. In the same year, she enrolled in postgraduate studies and defended her master's thesis in 1997. She completed and defended her doctoral dissertation in 2003 in the field of ecology and botany. From 1992 to 1996, she worked at the Department of Plant Ecology and Geography of the Faculty of Biology as a professional associate. She was employed at the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine in 1999 as an assistant in the Forage Plants course. After defending her doctoral dissertation, she was elected to the position of assistant professor, then associate professor, and since 2016 she has been a full professor at the Department of Animal Nutrition and Botany. She is the subject teacher for the compulsory subject Botany and the elective subject Medicinal and poisonous plants of the Balkans. Scientific field of work and interests are nutrition and botany.
