Short biography: Dr. Ana Vulić is a Scientific Advisor and Head of the Analytical Chemistry Laboratory at the Croatian Veterinary Institute in Zagreb. She holds a PhD in Biotechnological Sciences and Food Technology from the University of Zagreb (2011). Her research focuses on the quality and safety of food and animal feed, with special emphasis on the detection of contaminants such as mycotoxins, and the development of modern analytical methods. She has contributed to six national and international scientific projects and is currently involved in two EU-funded projects under the Croatian National Recovery Plan (2024–2027). Dr. Vulić has published five book chapters and over 50 peer-reviewed articles. She actively participates in the scientific community as a member of editorial and evaluation panels, including the journal Foods and the Croatian Science Foundation (2023–2027), and has presented her work at multiple international and domestic conferences. Her work also includes expert contributions to the TAIEX programme in the field of food safety.
