Short biography: Ksenija Nešić, DVM, MSc, PhD, from the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine at the University of Belgrade, in her research explores the connections within the food chain through the "One Health" concept. Her primary focus is on nutritional toxicology, particularly mycotoxicology, along with the investigation of other harmful substances, as well as detection and diagnostic measures necessary to prevent foodborne illnesses. Her scientific work also aims to enhance laboratory methods for feed control and examines how animal nutrition impacts the quality of animal-derived food. Notably, she engages in international collaborations with leading European institutions and is an active member of various domestic and international associations. Additionally, she serves on the editorial boards of prominent national and international scientific journals and participates in shaping feed legislation in the Republic of Serbia, ultimately benefiting end consumers.
