She is an assistant professor working in the field of Food Technology at the Faculty of Agriculture and Food Sciences, University of Sarajevo. Her teaching activity includes lecturing on the following modules: Technology of meat, fish and eggs, Technology of oil and fat and Technology of ready-made food. She mentored a large number of undergraduate and master's theses. She participated in numerous seminars, training sessions, and courses in the field of Food Technology. She participated in national and international congresses and symposiums with a total of 48 presentations of scientific research papers. She was involved in the implementation of several national and international projects. To date, she is the author or co-author of 41 scientific papers and one book.
