Short biography: Full professor at the Department of Animal Nutrition and Botany, Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, University of Belgrade. She graduated in 1991, received her master's degree in 2005 and her doctorate in 2007 from the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, University of Belgrade. As the first author, she published (in 2008) the university textbook "Food Safety for Animals", and as a co-author of "Nutrition Workshop" in 2022. She has published over 400 papers in the field of nutrition in leading international journals (30 papers), domestic journals, and proceedings of international and domestic conferences. She supervised the preparation of 14 doctoral dissertations, and was a member of the evaluation and defense committees in eight more. She also supervised and was a member of the evaluation and defense committees of master's theses, specialist and diploma theses. She has completed the following training courses: Dairy Nutrition and Feed Quality Workshop, United States Department of Agriculture; Sensory assessment, training and personnel training for food sensory analysis; HACCP - system creation, implementation and verification, Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, Belgrade; "EU regulations in the field of animal feed and their implementation", Chamber of Commerce, Serbia, Belgrade; Better Training for Safer Food – "Food Composition and Information", Greece. She is a member of the Serbian Veterinary Society, the Veterinary Chamber of Serbia, the Editorial Board of the journal Meat Technology and a member of the Council of Medical Scientific Areas University of Belgrade.
