Short biography: Aleksandra Uzelac obtained her MSc degree in Microbiology and Molecular Genetics from Rutgers University in New Jersey, USA and her PhD in Molecular Biology of Eukaryotes from the University of Belgrade. She was employed at the Center for Emerging Pathogens of the Rutgers Medical School in Newark, USA until 2011 and in 2014, she joined the Institute for Medical Research. Her diverse research experience includes bacterial genetics, protein engineering, population genetics of parasites and epidemiology. She has been engaged in several research projects funded by the NIH and a national project in Serbia. Currently, she is the PI of Worm Profiler, a 2-year project funded by the Science Fund of the Republic of Serbia.
