Short biography: Dejan Perić was born in Brčko, Republika Srpska, BiH. After graduating in 2017 with an average grade of 9.68, he enrolled in doctoral academic studies at the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine at the University of Belgrade. Since May 3, 2018, he has been engaged in the project of the Ministry of Education, Science and Technological Development "Selected biological hazards for safety through the quality of food of animal origin and control measures from the farm to the consumer" as a researcher at the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine. In 2019, he was elected to the position of teaching assistant at the Department of Animal Nutrition and Botany of the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine. Since the election to the title of assistant, he has been participating in practical teaching at the basic integrated academic studies of the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine in the subjects Nutrition 1, Nutrition 2 and Botany. In 2024, he defended his doctoral dissertation at the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, and in 2025, he was elected to the position of assistant professor. As an author and co-author, he participated in the creation of over 90 scientific papers and short content, three technical solutions, and held 9 lectures by invitation at meetings of national and international significance. He is a member of the Serbian Veterinary Society and the Serbian Veterinary Chamber.
